Thursday, Oct. 16 at 10:30 AM

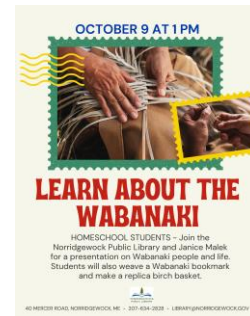
Pig the Pug Monster by Aaron Blabey

Thursday, Oct. 30 at 5 PM

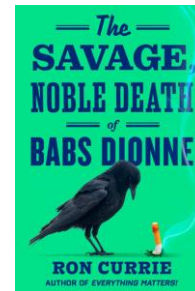
Book Club members will be reading The Sea Flower by Ruth Moore for October and then discussing the book at their October meeting.

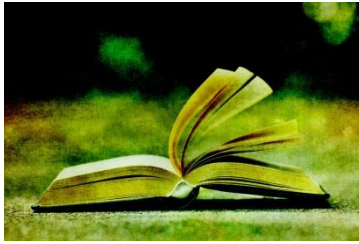

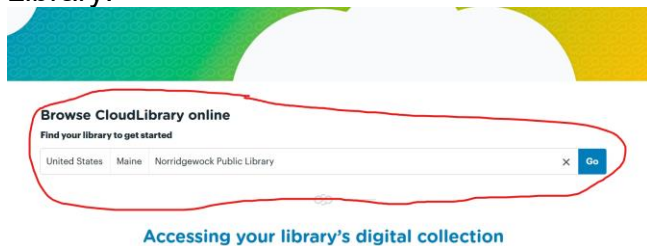

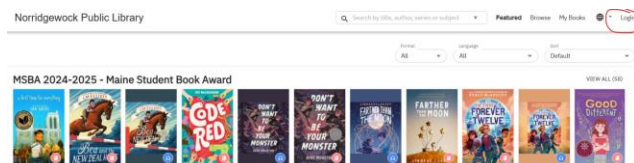
Mentions from the Librarian

With the weather turning cooler and gardens coming to a close, it is a great time to find a comfy chair and read. One of the many options we have at the library is the Cloud Library that allows you to check out eBooks and audiobooks to read or listen to on your phone or e reader app such as Kindle or Nook. Here is a short tutorial to get started.

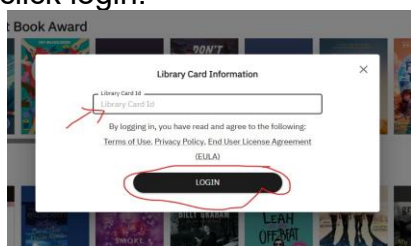
Go to <https://www.yourcloudlibrary.com>. The beginning screen will ask you to find your library. Use the drop-down menus to enter United States, Maine, Norridgewock Public Library.



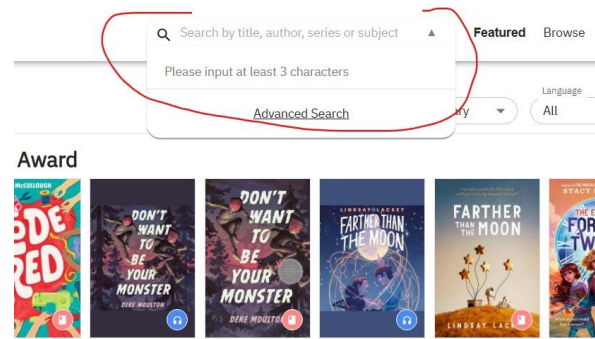
Click on the Go button. It will take you to the library's bookshelf main page. In the upper right-hand corner, you will see the login button.



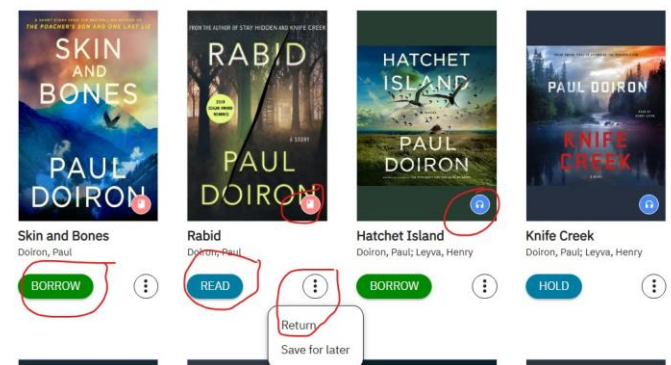
Click on Login and a new box in the center of the page will appear. Enter your library card number from the Norridgewock Library and click login.



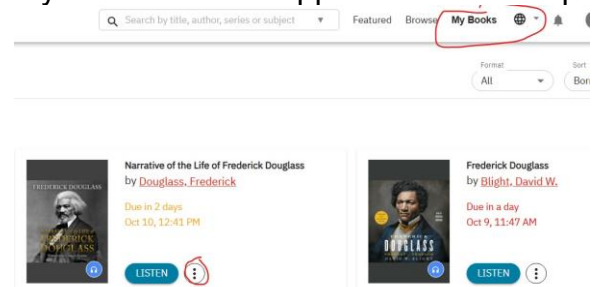
Once logged in, you can search for eBooks by title or author. The search button is at the top center of the page.



For example, I searched Paul Doiron. His books that the Cloud Library has are listed. I choose a book and then clicked on the Borrow button below the book picture. The button then changes to blue and you can click read. When finished, you can go back to the book and click on the three dots next to it and select return.



Worth noting, the icon in the bottom right corner tells you if it is an ebook or an audiobook. Books can be found in the MyBooks section. Upper Middle of the page.
