



Town Manager's Report
May 1, 2019

Smithfield Fire has decided not to renew its lease agreement for space on the current tower, which is shared with Norridgewock. I will be working with the Town of Smithfield to ensure that the ownership of the equipment within the existing structure becomes the property of the Town of Norridgewock. We are unsure of how this will impact future lease rates, at present time.

In the next two weeks, we are looking to finish up the airport gate, as well as repair the fence at the Town Office. Pending a decision by the Board, it is likely that repairs may begin at the ballfields next week. Repairs at the ballfield are essential for player safety.

We are proceeding to small claims for those personal property taxpayers who did not respond to the First-Class notification. We were able to collect from two taxpayers, one responded to the document service, and two are going to be served by the Sheriff's Office. In order to remain with the timeline, filings to the court must be completed by May 20.

We have the permit in-hand for the boat launch rehabilitation. I've been working with Bonneau's to finalize paperwork (bond, insurance, etc.) so we are prepared to move as soon after June 15 as possible.
